With your interests in mind

With all-important health and safety and environmental risks in mind, AECC requires that all food and drink for consumption during All-Energy '09 be purchased from them – or alternatively supplied through them. However, they do recognise that some companies may already have existing contracts with caterers they would prefer to use during the show. It is a requirement that all exhibitors who wish to employ the services of an external caterer purchase a permit for the privilege of doing so. The permit will only be issued providing all requirements under Health and Safety and Food Hygiene Regulations are in place. You, or your outside caterer need to provide a written health and safety policy, risk assessments for the operation, hazard analysis and critical control points, and adequate insurance cover. AECC reserves the right to refuse any permit on the grounds that information provided does not adhere with current regulations.

- Full Permit @ £650.00 + VAT
- Food Permit @ £325.00 + VAT
- Beverage Permit @ £325.00 + VAT
