

Active presenting at All-Energy's first Education Day

Sustainable energy solutions firm Active will give a number of presentations at the first ever Education Day at All-Energy. The Education Day will be held at the AECC on the 20th of May 2010. Active will be exhibiting at stand H60 for the two-day All-Energy event.
